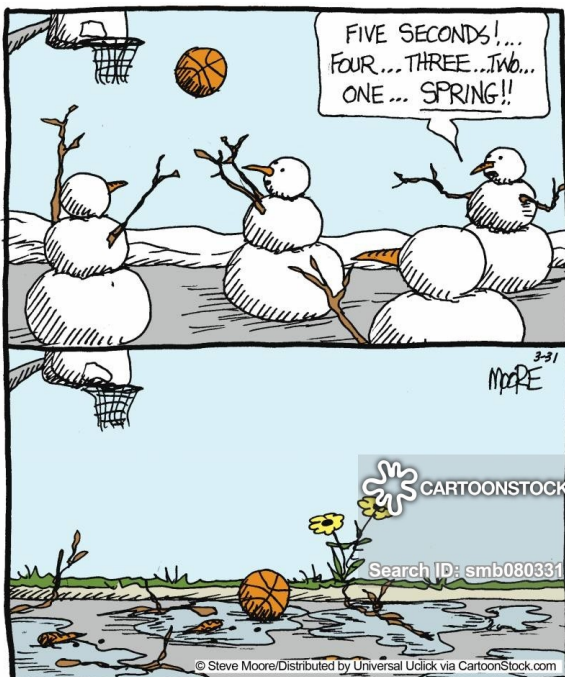
DID YOU KNOW?

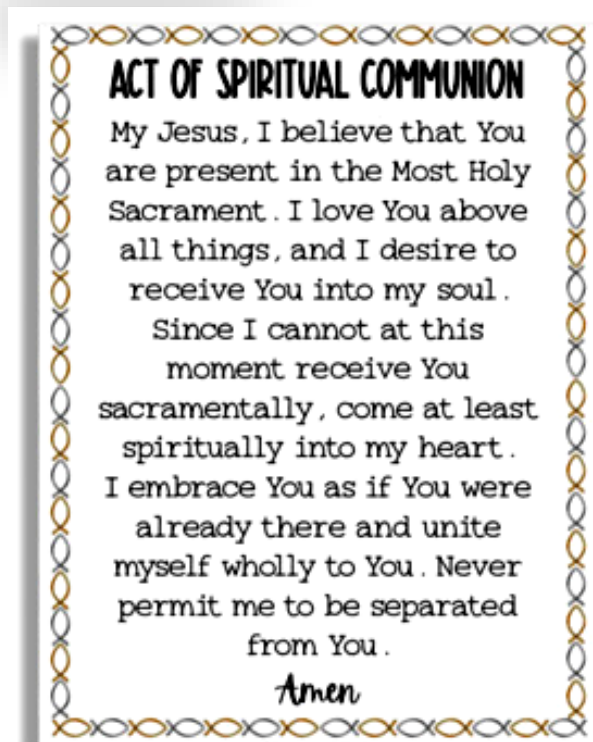
Let us continue to pray for those who are ill at this time, those who are preparing for and awaiting results of tests, those in hospital.
