The story tells us that the shepherds helped Mary to realise the significance of the child born


to her. She treasured their words and pondered their meaning. Who have been the people who have helped you to understand the meaning of significant events in your life? Remember them gratefully.

My Jesus, I Believe that you are present In the Most Holy Sacrament.


I love you above all things And desire to receive you in my soul. Since I cannot at this moment receive you
