4<sup>th</sup> - 29<sup>th</sup> October 2023 First Session Assembly of the Synod of Bishops in Rome

Bishop Brendan Leahy is one of two Bishops who will be travelling from Ireland to take part in the Assembly in Rome in October. Welcoming the announcement, Bishop Leahy said, "I very much look forward to the gathering in October. I believe the positive engagement and valuable inputs on the part of many in Ireland in the Synodal pathway to date have helped to prepare me. 'I pray that the October assembly will be a time of going deeper still, in listening together with participants from across the world to what the Spirit is saying to the Church at this time, so often described by Pope Francis as an era of transformation".

Bishop Leahy reflected that, "The Synodal Process is about conversion, and we pray that all participants will be open in mind and heart to what the Holy Spirit wants of each individually, and collectively. In light of Pope Francis' comment that 'without prayer there will be no Synod', we encourage people of faith to unceasingly pray to God over the coming weeks at daily and weekend Masses, at home, and in religious communities, to intercede for Pope Francis and for all members of the Synodal Assembly."

## Fundraising for the "Street Children" of Kolkata (Calcutta)

With the kind permission of Fr. Richie Davern, I Seosamh Ó Cuinneagáin (Joe Cunningham) would like to make my annual appeal for donations on behalf of the Street Children of Kolkata (Calcutta), who live in abject poverty, at all the weekend Masses on Saturday and Sunday 7th and 8th October 2023 respectively in St. Mary's and St. Nicholas Churches. This is a humanitarian crisis of enormous proportion. I came to know about the Street children many vears ago through Fr. Derek Leonard who was a curate in our parish of Mungret-Crecora-Raheen. Fr. Derek is also a past pupil of mine from Ardscoil Rís secondary school here in Limerick. All donations go directly to these poor children for food, education and general welfare. I am returning again to Kolkata at the end of November and I cover all my traveling, medical and accommodation expenses. I have been teaching English to the Street Children in Kolkata since 2011 where I have experienced extreme poverty, suffering and unnecessary deaths as a result of man's inhumanity to man. I also help with the sick and dying in Mother Teresa's hospice, in Kalighat in the heart of the slums. I would be very much obliged if you could contribute towards this worthy cause.
