Following on from our notice in last week's newsletter, we had several people call to the office and request a box of Offertory Envelopes.

By donating to our church using this system, your donation is recorded against your Offertory Envelope number and this acts as a record of your donation. If your annual donation exceeds €250, the Parish can then claim back the tax on your donation from Revenue. This is a great source of additional funding for the Parish.

To claim this tax back, a CHY4 form is generated annually by the Parish which you will be asked to sign, it's a very easy process. We kindly ask that you consider contributing using this system. We sincerely thank all who already donate in this way.
