Bishop Leahy recently invited the National Board for Safeguarding children in the Catholic Church into the Limerick diocese to conduct an audit of best practice. Following this initiative, representatives visited our parish and specifically observed the children's choir practice on two occasions. They also met with parish representatives and thoroughly inspected relevant records and form keeping.
