
St Nicholas, 6th December

Each tag lists a person and an age group e.g "Girl age 4". We ask people to spend up to €15 on each child.


You can return the unwrapped gift in a bag to the church, which will be distributed locally by St. Vincent de Paul Society and Barnardos.
