

The Irish Blood Transfusion Service remains challenged to keep pace with the current demand from hospitals for blood products post covid.

The maximum period any blood type can be kept in storage is 35 days. The current national stock across all blood types is currently 5.2 days. Lowest blood type stock is for B- for which the IBTS currently hold 3.9 days. So, the IBTS is urging new and existing Blood Donors to please make and keep appointments. The recently introduced clinic booking system is proving extremely popular with Blood Donors. The overwhelming majority now complete their blood giving and existed the clinic is less than one hour.

## Did you know?

Did you know that approximately 1000 people in Ireland get blood transfusions every week. Transfusions can happen for a variety of reasons cancer treatment, surgery, car accidents, and childbirth complications to name a few.

- 1 in 4 of us will need a blood transfusion in our lifetime
- 67% of donated blood is used to treat cancer patients & people with blood disorders.
- 27% of donated blood is used in surgery and emergency situations
- 6% of donated blood is used to treat blood loss after childbirth & to help premature babies

100% of donated blood is precious and saves lives in Ireland every day.
