

#### Trocaire "Ebola Crisis"

Almost 9,000 people in West Africa have been infected with the Ebola virus, with approximately 4,500 people having died. The three most affected countries are Liberia, Guinea and Sierra Leone, Over 3,000 cases have been identified in Sierra Leone, with the virus present in all districts where Trócaire works.

We are helping to provide food and non-food items to people in quarantined households We are funding our response through a combination of existing funds, donations from supporters to our 'Ebola Crisis' fund and grants from institutional donors. The epidemic is having a knock-on effect on healthcare more generally: people aren't seeking treatment for other serious illnesses like malaria, because they're afraid of being infected with Ebola.

Ebola is affecting every aspect of people's lives, and it's forcing communities further into poverty. Families can't afford food, schools are closed, travel restrictions are in place, and people live in perpetual fear
