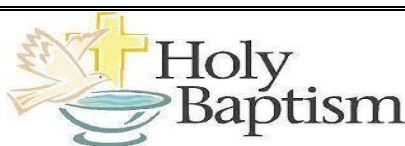

During both Masses, the name of each person will be called out and a family member can come forward to light a candle in their memory (*we will have prepared the candle on the sanctuary for you - the family do not need to bring a candle*).

There will also be an opportunity for people to go to the back of the church and collect a lit candle which they can bring forward in memory of a loved one whose funeral was celebrated elsewhere.
